| Key issues discussed | Alison Monteith and John O Neill from Venture Intl Consultants gave a presentation on Peace Plus. They emphasised the importance of codesigned projects with Grassroots Collaboration. It was hoped to have applications by March of next year but it looked as if it would now be the end of June next year. |
| Key decisions made | A total of 70+ community projects were approved funding under the Community Enhancement Fund. Grants ranged from €500 to €5000. At the LAG Meeting a total of 8 projects were approved for funding – 5 private business and 3 community projects. |
| Action(s) required from the PPN: | PPN Reps and members of the LCDC were encouraged to liaise through Orla Brady in Monaghan Co.Co.with regard to queries , suggestions or proposals for Peace Plus PPN Groups should be encouraged to apply for Leader Funding. The PPN Reps are happy to advise and help groups with their applications. |
| Issues the PPN should be aware of: | The PPN should be looking for proposals from member groups for suitable collaborate projects for Peace Plus. The PPN were awarded €5000 from the Community Enhancement Fund for the purchase of Tablets. The PPN should be aware of the shortage of community projects coming forward for Leader Funding with more than 60% of Leader money going towards private businesses. |
